We invite you to join us in the peace and serenity of the Eastern Sierra for this special weekend of fellowship and recovery.

Greetings from Mammoth Lakes, California. Although we still have a lot of snow on the ground, our thoughts are turning to summer and our annual event, and we are extending a warm invitation for you to join us!

The campground we've used for several years, Pine Glen, isn't available this year because of construction. We looked for another campground with enough group sites and a place for large speaker meetings, and didn't find one that would work. So we came up with a different plan for THIS year.

The centerpiece of the event will be an all-day, catered gathering at Little Eagle Lodge, 400 Majestic Pines Rd, located at the base of "Chair 15/Eagle Express." The gathering will include Continental Breakfast and a morning workshop with our speakers, Georgia B., Steve L., and Kent C., from about 9 to noon; a mid-day break with the opportunity for a hike and lunch AA meeting in the Lakes Basin; an early evening AA speaker meeting with Georgia B; Barbeque dinner; sobriety countdown, and an 8:00 p.m. AA speaker meeting with Kent C. The cost of the meals and registration is \$50 per person. We are sorry, but no dogs are permitted in the Lodge.

On Friday evening, August 25th, there will be a cookout/potluck in the parking lot of our meeting hall, located at the south-west corner of the intersection of Main Street and Minaret, with an AA speaker meeting to follow at 8:00 p.m.

We will also hold our regular Sunday AA "Jelly Doughnut" meeting at 9 a.m. on the 27th at the Meeting House location.

Camping is not included with our reservation process this year. Camp High Sierra is within easy walking distance of Eagle Lodge; reservations may be made by calling 800 Mammoth or by visiting Mammothmountain.com. Book early!

There are many campsites in the Mammoth Lakes area; reservations may be made at Recreation.gov. In addition, there are many lodging options in Mammoth Lakes, which can be reserved through numerous lodging websites.

We hope that the changes that we've found necessary this year will provide a great sober experience for all, and we look forward to seeing you in August! Please complete and return the registration slip below at your earliest convenience so we can plan ahead for the number of meals. We need a final headcount for food no later than July 21. As a reminder, there is no charge for attending AA meetings; the registration fee is to cover the cost of food.
